Rome

An International Seminar on THE EUROPEAN GREAT PROJECTS

Organized by the European Physical Society

As announced in the October issue of *Europhysics News* in the report on the Council and General Meeting, EPS is organizing in Rome in March, 1979, a two-day international seminar at which the following very big European physics projects of great importance to the future of European physics will be presented :

1. Radio Astronomy Projects in the Millimetre Range
2. Fusion Programme of Western Europe
3. TeV Fixed Target Proton Synchrotron Projects
4. Large Synchrotron Radiation Sources
5. Big Projects in Astroscience
6. LEP, Large e^+e^- Colliding Beam Project.

The programme will begin at 15 h 00 on 26 March and, in each session, a

lecture of 50 minutes will be followed by a 40 minute discussion.

Participation is limited to about 300 people of whom the majority will be invited through the National Societies, to ensure as even a representation as possible. This will also encourage a wide diffusion of information on the projects afterwards.

A certain number of places, however, have not been allocated and applications from people with a particular reason to be present will be considered by the organizing committee. Such applications should be sent to the EPS Secretariat.

The Proceedings of the Seminar will be published by the European Physical Society. Individual Ordinary Members will receive a special discount.

No registration fee is to be charged for the Seminar.
