



Hewlett-Packard Europhysics Prize Call for Nominations 1979 Award

The EPS Selection Committee for the Hewlett-Packard Europhysics Prize (awarded annually for outstanding achievement in the field of solid state physics) will be pleased to consider for the 1980 award, candidates nominated by members of the Society.

The award is made in recognition of a recent work by one or more individuals in the area of physics of condensed matter, specifically work leading to advances in the fields of electronic, electrical and materials engineering which, in the opinion of the Society's selection committee, represents scientific excellence. "Recent work" is defined to mean completed within 5 years prior to the award.

With any proposal, the committee needs:

a clear definition of the work in question,
a short biography of the candidate,
a list of relevant publications and reprints of publications describing the work for which the award would be made.

Such details should be sent to the committee c/o the Executive Secretary, at the EPS Secretariat to arrive not later than Dec. 1, 1979. Early submission will be appreciated.

All information will be treated as confidential, but the Selection Committee wishes it to be understood that it cannot enter into correspondence over its selection.

The 1979 prize as announced last month has been awarded to:

Yuri V. Gulaev, of Moscow,
Kjell A. Ingebrigtsen, of Trondheim,
Edward G. S. Paige, of Oxford.

All made important contributions to our understanding of the interaction between surface acoustic waves and electrons, and to the development of new devices based on this knowledge.

Presentation of the award, which is worth 20 000 Sw. Fr., will be made at the opening of the EPS Conference on the Physics of Semiconductor Surfaces and Interfaces to be held in Paris, 26-28 November, 1979.

EPS Scholarships

Candidates for EPS Scholarships that have been offered in the Federal Republic of Germany, Italy, Poland, Romania and Switzerland, should write to the EPS Secretariat for an application form, stating briefly their proposal.

For scholarships which are tenable at Universities and Institutes and are related to the 1979/80 academic year, immediate application is advised. In all cases, candidates should remember that a certain time is needed to deal with requests even though the administrative processes have been cut to a minimum.

Similarly for Special Scholarships applicable to courses at the Ettore Majorana international centre in Erice, application should be made to the EPS Secretariat as early as possible.
