Criteria for EPS Recognition

While all meetings that seem likely to be of interest to European physicists, and which are known to the Secretariat, are listed free of charge in the Meetings Issues of *Europhysics News*, certain events are singled out for special mention (see below). These are: Europhysics Conferences, Europhysics Study Conferences and Sponsored Conferences. All of these must satisfy certain criteria that have been laid down and must pass through a refereeing procedure before being accepted. Schools are treated in a similar way.

Provisional application for recognition is made by the organizers to the Secretariat in Geneva who will send the appropriate forms and detailed comments on rules. When the forms are returned, they are reviewed by the Conference Committee — an Advisory Committee of EPS which includes representatives of the Divisions and the different classes of EPS Members. Consultation over sponsoring takes time (even though the Committee works mainly by mail) and organizers must count on an interval of several weeks before a decision

is taken. Only when official notification of acceptance has been received can the EPS appellation be used. Organizers should, therefore, apply as soon as possible and at least nine months before the meeting date if they are to receive the full benefit of EPS recognition.

Europhysics Conferences

These are conferences organized by one or more of the Divisions or Sections of EPS. They will satisfy *inter alia* all the requirements for sponsorship having been conceived in an entirely European spirit. To be approved they will offer special rates to EPS members and, if abstracts are published, they will appear in the *Europhysics Conference Abstracts Series*. Nine such volumes were published in 1984 in Series 8, and a similar number will be produced in Series 9 covering 1985. Organizers of Europhysics Conferences are encouraged to charge fees that will allow them to contribute about SFR 10.—/participant to the EPS Young Physicists Fund.

Europhysics Study Conferences

These are topical conferences with a restricted number of invited participants (say 70, absolute maximum 100), the number from any one country not exceeding one third. They are distinct from schools in that the participants will be actively contributing to the field in question. They normally last several days (four to five) and no proceedings are published.

Sponsored Conferences and Schools

These are meetings that are not organized within the EPS but are considered to fulfil the following criteria:

- 1) they satisfy a genuine need and new material will be presented;
- 2) they are of high quality;
- 3) the scientific programme has been prepared by an international committee;
- 4) there will be international participation — not more than one third from one or half from two countries;
- 5) there are no restrictions other than scientific on attendance;
- 6) conference fees are not excessive.

Guide to Entries

Europhysics News has published in 1984 two Meetings Issues: in March and October. Urgent up-datings were also included in the June Directory Issue in the form of advertisements charged at Sw.Fr. 100.— per insertion.

The events listed here are those for which details were received at the EPS Secretariat by the end of September 1984. In general, all events interesting European physicists which take place from two months after the date of publication are quoted. Most readers will already have taken their decision regarding earlier events but like to have as long an advance notice as possible of future happenings.

The listings are in date order divided into two categories — Conferences and Schools. Europhysics Conferences, i.e. meetings organized by EPS, its Divisions and Sections, are printed in bold type and boxed; events sponsored by EPS are printed in bold type; Europhysics Study Conferences are marked by an **E** preceding the date.

For inclusion in the March 1985 issue, organizers should send available details to the EPS Secretariat by 25 February 1985. Even if full details are not yet available, the preliminary information should be given.

Application for sponsorship should be made to the EPS Secretariat in Geneva.

Note that candidates must be established physicists who are either EPS Individual Members themselves or sponsored by an EPS Individual Member. Furthermore, because of the pressure of demand, these scholarships are now available only for those schools that are sponsored by EPS.

EUROPEAN JOURNAL OF PHYSICS

By the end of 1984, No. 4 of Vol. 5 of the *European Journal of Physics* will have been published, so fulfilling the promise that the schedule would be made to coincide with the calendar year.

The journal was launched in June 1980 as a joint venture between the EPS and The Institute of Physics of the UK (IoP). The Editorial Board is appointed by the two societies in conjunction and the actual publishing work is undertaken by the IoP in the name of EPS.

To begin with, articles of the high quality demanded were slow to come in and only through the persistent efforts of the Editor, Professor G.W. Series, and the Board was the rate brought up to the required level. Numbers were not a problem, it was a question of the right quality and the right area. There are indeed still misconceptions over the purpose of the journal which is designed essentially to serve as a communication medium between those engaged in the teaching of advanced physics at the universities, technical colleges, etc. As a result, its prime interest is in teaching methods, techniques and coping with the difficulties met in the lecture hall, but space is also devoted to other subjects that academics discuss amongst themselves.
