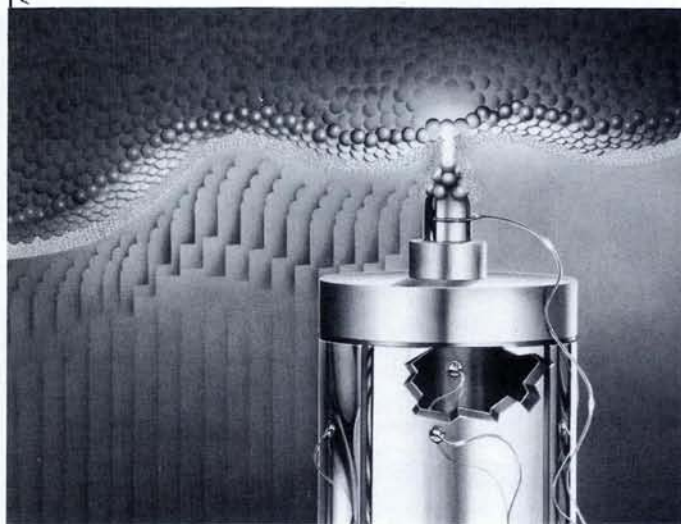

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### Holweck Prize

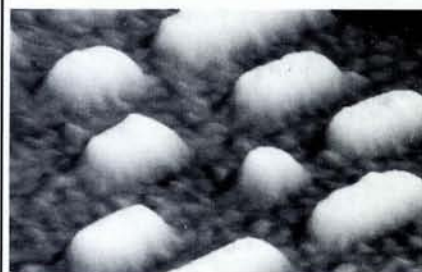
Roger Cowley, Dr. Lee's Professor of Experimental Physics and head of department at the Clarendon Laboratory, Oxford University since 1988, has been awarded the 1990 Holweck Prize, given jointly by The Institute of Physics and the French Physical Society, for accomplishments in theoretical and experimental aspects of neutron and X-ray scattering.

### Max Born Medal and Prize

Ernst Göbel, full professor of physics at the University of Marburg since 1985, has been awarded the 1991 Max Born Medal and Prize, given jointly by The Institute of Physics and the German Physical Society, for contributions in the field of the optical spectroscopy of semiconductors. Born in 1946, he studied at the Universities of Frankfurt and Stuttgart.



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
